

ORDINANCE NO. 151-79

An ordinance amending Section 1. of Ordinance No. 14-78, adopted by the North Canton City Council January 23, 1978, thereby amending the ceiling of total income allowable for eligibility under the Homestead Exemption Act from \$7,000.00 per year to the maximum total income permitting any reduction in tax rate pursuant to Section 323.152 of OHIO REVISED CODE, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 1. of Ordinance No. 14-78, be, and is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1.

That each resident of the City of North Canton who is a contracting party for the City of North Canton water and sewer service, and who applies for and receives a Homestead Exemption for the residence served, under the provisions of Section 323.151, et seq., OHIO REVISED CODE, and annually provides satisfactory proof of said exemption to the City of North Canton, shall be entitled to a senior citizens and disabled persons public utility exemption, reducing the charges for such services to such resident in accordance with the following schedule:

LEVEL OF TOTAL INCOME AS APPLIED TO HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION ACT	UTILITY PAYMENT REDUCTION
MAXIMUM TOTAL INCOME PERMITTING ANY REDUCTION IN TAX RATE PURSUANT TO SECTION 323.152 OF O.R.C.	25%

Section 2. That this ordinance be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton, Ohio, and immediately necessary in order to be in compliance with current Ohio State statutes, and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon adoption by the Mayor.
