RESOLUTION NO. 112-79

A resolution on submission of question of a renewal tax levy for the purpose of providing additional funds for the City's portion of street improvements in the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio.

WHEREAS, the City of North Canton upon due investigation and consideration has determined that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten (10) mill limitation in and for the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, for the next five (5) years will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the purpose of providing additional funds for the City's portion of street improvements in the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, by reason of the facts above set forth, the Council has determined that it should, and hereby does, declare itself to submit to the electors of the City of North Canton at the General Election to be held on November 6, 1979, the question of levying a renewal levy, of a tax outside the ten (10) mill limitation for the purpose of providing additional funds for the City's portion of street improvements in the City of North Canton for a period not to exceed five (5) years, tax years 1980, 1981, 1982, 1983 and 1984, said renewal levy to be at a rate not exceeding one (1) mill for each one dollar of valuation which amounts to ten cents (10¢) for each one hundred dollars of valuation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that there shall be submitted to the electors of said subdivision at the General Election on November 6, 1979, the question of levying a renewal of a tax levy outside the ten (10) mill limitation in and for said subdivision in the amount of one mill, for the purpose of providing additional funds for the City's portion of street improvements in the City of North Canton; and that said additional one (1) mill shall be levied for five years, tax years 1980, 1981, 1982, 1983 and 1984.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the submission of said proposal, the notice of election, the form of ballot, the certificate of the levy as voted outside the ten (10) mill limitation, and the levying of such additional millage shall be in accordance with the provisions of Section 5705.19 and 5705.25 and other related Sections of the OHIO REVISED CODE, in accordance with the statutes in such cases made and provided; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the form of the ballot cast at such election shall be:

(A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.)

"A renewal tax for the benefit of the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, for the purpose of providing additional funds for the City's portion of street improvements in the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, at a rate not exceeding one (1) mill for each one dollar of valuation which amounts to ten cents (10¢) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years, to wit: tax years 1980, 1981, 1982, 1983 and 1984."
