ORDINANCE 09 - 2021

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file with the Department of Administration for a vehicle exhaust venting system to be installed at North Canton Fire Station 1 and fully funded by a Federal Emergency Management Agency grant, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, the North Canton Fire Department has received a grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency for the costs of installing a vehicle exhaust venting system at North Canton Fire Station 1; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to seek bids for the installation of a vehicle exhaust venting system as promptly as possible to facilitate the completion of the project this calendar year and ensure compliance with the provisions of the grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That the Director of Administration be, and is hereby, authorized to advertise and received bids according to specifications now on file with the Department of Administration for the installation of a vehicle exhaust venting system at North Canton Fire Station 1.
- Section 2. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and peace of the City of North Canton; and; further necessary to facilitate completion of the above-described project this calendar year and ensure compliance with the provisions of the above-mentioned grant, wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its adoption by Council, together with the Mayor's approval. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
