ORDINANCE 26 - 2022

An ordinance amending Chapter 103, Official Standards, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton, in order to adopt a new City Seal.

WHEREAS, the City has previously removed "the Dogwood City" from the City's Branding; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to adopt a more modern common seal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That Chapter 103, Official Standards, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton, be and is hereby amended in its entirety to read as set forth in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- Section 2. That the Clerk of Council and Mayor of the City of North Canton be, and are hereby, authorized to make such amendments as may be needed to the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton to accurately reflect this ordinance upon approval of such amended pages by a voice vote of Council.
- Section 3. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

CHAPTER 103– OFFICIAL STANDARDS

SECTION 103.01 COMMON SEAL

There is hereby established and adopted a common seal for the City of North Canton, Ohio, which common seal is attached hereto and incorporated herein.



SECTION 103.02 USE OF FACSIMILE SIGNATURES

(a) A policy for the use of facsimile signatures by public officials, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code § 9.11 is hereby adopted.

(b) A policy prohibiting the use of rubber stamp signatures by public officials, pursuant to the definition of facsimile signature in Ohio Revised Code § 9.10 is hereby adopted.
