ORDINANCE 29 - 2022

An ordinance amending Chapter 137 Department of Police, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton, specifically Section 137.04, Personnel, in order to increase the authorized number of police sergeants to six.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has requested that the personnel cap for police sergeants be raised from 5 to 6 in order to permit the employment of two sergeants on each shift; and

WHEREAS, it is believed that the new position can be provided for within existing budgetary resources and that the added position will assist in limiting overtime occurrences.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Chapter 137 Department of Police, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton, specifically Section 137.04, Personnel, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 137.04 PERSONNEL

(a) Authorized Manpower. That the total number of persons to be employed by the Police Department and the classifications set forth herein shall not exceed the following number of persons in each classification, unless additional budgeted positions receive funding from outside sources by written agreement:

Section 2. That the Clerk of Council and Mayor of the City of North Canton be, and are hereby, authorized to make such amendments as may be needed to the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton to accurately reflect this ordinance upon approval of such amended pages by a voice vote of Council.

Section 3. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
